Guidelines: (University Rule 31.08.01.M1) All faculty members who retire from TAMU in good standing with the rank of Associate Professor, Professor, or Distinguished Professor may be nominated to the Board of Regents as Associate Professor Emeritus, Professor Emeritus, or Distinguished Professor Emeritus. A letter of recommendation (including a statement that the faculty member retired in good standing) should be sent from the academic department to the Dean of Faculties, accompanied by the faculty member's curriculum vitae.

The present Committee on Emeritus Status has become an appellate committee charged with reviewing (a) nominations for faculty emeritus appointments other than those defined above; and (b) appeals by faculty members who are retiring at the rank of Associate Professor, Professor, or Distinguished Professor, but who are not being nominated (because they have not retired in good standing).
