

Department of Teaching, Learning and Culture Process for Post-Tenure Peer Review

The Department has an elected faculty evaluation committee that does peer reviews of all tenure-line faculty annual evaluation (A1) in the spring semester. The committee is composed of 3 full professors (2 year term), 2 associate professors (2 year term) and 1 assistant professor (1 year term).

With the College of Education and Human Development Guidelines approved on August 2, 2011, the committee will now provide peer review of tenured faculty in the areas of teaching, research, and service. The expected level of performance in each area will follow the department requirements according to each faculty member's rank and work assignment for the year or three-year averages. The committee will submit its review for each tenured faculty member to the department head prior to the submission date for A2 reports to the college in the spring, with sufficient time for the department head to incorporate the findings into the A2 evaluation of each faculty member with respect to post-tenure review status.

The department will follow the CEHD Post-Tenure Review guidelines approved by the DOF on October 4, 2011.
